A NURSERY

If your child was born between 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016 you need to apply for a Nursery place for **September 2019**.

All 3-4 year olds are entitled to 15 funded Nursery hours per week, however, if you are a two parent working family or a lone working parent (earning less than £100,000 per year) you will be eligible to apply for the additional 15 hours of funded hours.
